THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court on application of Plaintiff for an Order to Show Cause, seeking relief by way of temporary restraints pursuant to *R. 4:52*; and Plaintiff having provided notice to the Office of the Attorney General in accordance with *R. 4:28-4(a)*; and the Attorney General having not yet sought to intervene; and the 60-day period within which the Attorney General may intervene, under *R. 4:28-4(d)*, having not yet expired; and the Court having heard oral argument on the 23rd of August, 2023; and for good cause being shown;

IT IS on this 23rd day of August, 2023, ORDERED that

- 1) State Solicitor Jeremy Feigenbaum or another designee of the Office of the Attorney General shall appear before Judge Joseph L. Rea of the Middlesex County Superior Court, Courtroom 406, on Wednesday, August 30, 2023, at 1:30 p.m.;
- 2) A representative of the Office of the Attorney General shall be prepared to explain that office's position on whether R. 4:28-4(d) ^{grant interlocutory relief in this case} allows the Court to ~~issue temporary restraints~~ prior to the expiration of the 60-day period within which the Attorney General may seek to intervene;
- 3) Should the any counsel wish to appear remotely, they must contact Judge Rea's chambers.
